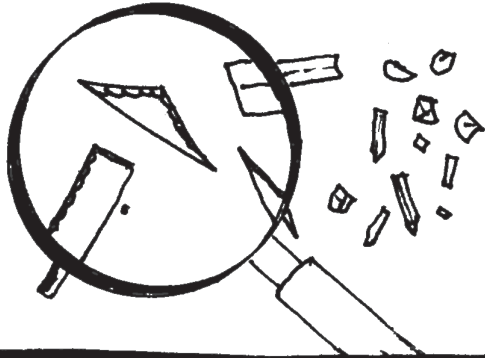
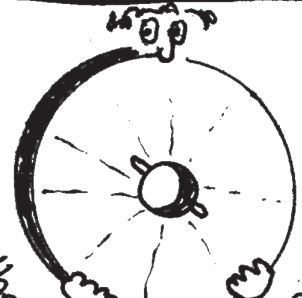


What does a lithic specialist do all day?

I look at lots of small stones

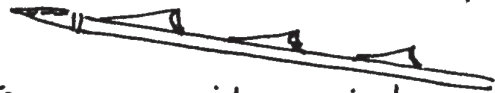


...and put them into bags!

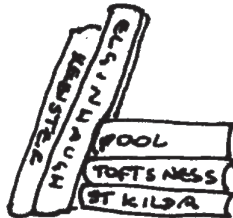
